Lancaster Depew Ponytails Rules

Pee Wee

- 4 Pitch Rule 4 coach pitches then go to tee
- 2 Coaches on the field for defense
- Outs count remove runner from bases infinite outs per inning
- Bat through the order each inning
- Station-to-Station -Runners advance one base at a time last batter gets a home run defense remains on the field until the last batter touches home plate
- Always finish the play throw to first, touch the base
- Play softball positions infielders in infield, outfielders in outfield
- Challenge each player according to their ability
- Player of the game token

Juniors

- A complete game consists of 6 innings. An official game will be at the discretion of the Junior Division coordinator.
- There will be no forfeits and no minimum requirements to play
- Mercy Rule 15 runs after 5 innings. 5 Run rule Teams switch after 5 runs are scored except the fifth and sixth inning.
- Players in the field Teams will play 10 players on defense if both teams have 10 players, otherwise teams will play defense with 9 players. Softball positions only. Outfielders must play on the grass.
- Leadoffs/Stealing Players may leadoff/steal only after the ball leaves the pitcher's hand. Stealing of home is not permitted.
- Players may only advance home on a batted ball or a base on balls. Players may not advance to home on a pickoff throw to any base.
- Pitching / Catching each player may pitch / catch a maximum of 3 innings per game. In the event of extra innings in a playoff game, there are no restrictions.
- Hit By Pitch A pitcher can hit at most 2 batters per inning before she will be removed for that inning. A pitcher can hit at most 3 batters per game before she will be removed for that game. A ball that hits the dirt and then hits the batter is considered a ball (unless the batter swings) and does not constitute being hit by pitch. Throwing one pitch per inning consumes one inning for the pitcher.
- A play is ended when the pitcher has control of the ball in the pitcher's circle. The play ending means that base runners may, at most, continue to the base they are approaching.
- Two by Two Rule All players may play no more than 2 innings at the same position (except pitchers and catchers) and each player must play 2 innings in the infield.
- No Forfeits ever Share players and make it work!

Ponytails

- A complete game consists of 6 innings. An official game will be at the discretion of the Ponytails coordinator.
- Mercy Rule 15 runs after 5 innings. 5 Run Rule Teams switch after 5 runs are scored except for the fifth and six innings.
- 10 Players in the field softball positions only. Outfielders must play on grass.
- Balls that do NOT leave the infield Each runner may advance only one base.
- Halfway Rule On balls that make it to the outfield, runners may continue to advance until the ball reaches the infield. Upon reaching the infield, baserunners are limited to the base they are approaching and may be returned to the previous base if the umpire determines they were less than halfway to the next base. The defense can still make plays against these baserunners.
- 6 Total Pitches 3 player pitches, 3 coach pitches. An at-bat will continue on a foul ball on the last pitch. Strike outs count. No called strikes on coach pitches. No base on balls or hit by pitch. Both players and coaches will pitch from the full 30 feet.
- Pitching Limit Pitchers can pitch 2 innings per game. In the event of extra innings in a playoff game, there are no restrictions.
- Two By Two Rule All players may play no more than 2 innings at the same position and each player must play 2 innings in the infield.

Middle School

- An official game will be at the discretion of the Middle School coordinator.
- Mercy Rule 15 runs after 5 innings. 5 Run Rule Teams switch after 5 runs are scored except for the sixth and seventh inning.
- Leadoffs/Stealing Players may leadoff/steal only after the ball leaves the pitcher's hand. Stealing of home is permitted.
- Pitching / Catching each player may pitch / catch a maximum of 4 innings per game. In the event of extra innings in a playoff game, there are no restrictions.
- Dropped third strike is in effect.
- Hit By Pitch A pitcher can hit at most 2 batters per inning before she will be removed for that inning. A pitcher can hit at most 3 batters per game before she will be removed for that game. A ball that hits the dirt and then hits the batter is considered a ball (unless the batter swings) and does not constitute being hit by pitch. Throwing one pitch per inning consumes one inning for the pitcher.
- Runners may only advance one base on a base on balls.
- A play is ended when the pitcher has control of the ball in the pitcher's circle. The play ending means that base runners may, at most, continue to the base they are approaching.
- Two by Two Rule All players may play no more than 2 innings at the same position (except pitchers and catchers) and each player must play 2 innings in the infield.
